



#### The Pizza Oven

2 years ago, I bought a house in a small town and for some reason I thought building a pizza oven was a great project to embark on. This started me down a path that filled my weekends with burnt bread and crumbling mortar. But one rebuild completed and a knowledge of yeast activity primed for bar trivia I have zero regrets! I will break down this journey into 2 parts: the oven and the pizza.

#### The Oven

Anyone can make pizza in a normal oven but that's not a very interesting story and doesn't spark interest on a Tinder profile quite like "I've built my own wood fired pizza oven", second only to pictures of your pickup truck. So, what do you need to build your own? It helps to work in an industrial facility that happens to be doing repairs/maintenance on a high temperature furnace resulting in an excess of high temperature brick, or Home Depot....... you do you. As well, it helps if you work in an industrial facility with skilled millwrights that are more than happy to help you out with weld-

ing stainless steel. You want to use stainless as it won't react to the high heat negatively and it will protect your bricks from the direct flame.

I am no mason so I'm sure I did something wrong here, but I applied all the knowledge I gained as a GNCTR Captain to this project. I started with a concrete slab base and cinder block walls, I built a form to allow an elevated slab as the main base of the oven. Next. I laid out the fire brick and steel frame on the foundation into an A frame/ dome shape, I know it's not a perfect shape for convection but we're going to be operating well above 800of so I wasn't too worried. Ceramic wool, fire brick and high temp mortar were used to keep the heat in during operation. I fastened it all down with wire mesh and then finished off the outside with a stained stucco mix to make it weatherproof and look nice. I put a black chimney vent on top and waited a month for it all to cure into a homogenous mass. There you have it, an electrical engineers' description of masonry construction. Is it the best design? No. Is it perfect? Definitely not, but I'm damn proud of it.

#### The Pizza

Here is the useful part for 99.99% of anyone reading this. If you want good pizza you need good dough. If you want good dough you need a scale. Baking is chemistry and there isn't a chemist in the world who won't agree mass is king for measurements. Here is the easy part: the entire recipe is percentages, so it works for pizza for two or for pizza party's once those are allowed again. All units are in grams.

Flour = X Water = 0.7\*X = Y Salt = 0.02\*(X+Y) Yeast = 0.01\*(X+Y) Now this dough is going to be sticky (it is a very high hydration dough), you are going to think you did something wrong and question why you ever made pizza from an engineering newspaper but have faith. There is no need to "wake" up your yeast or let it bloom, just don't use old yeast and this won't be an issue. Add all your ingredients into a mixing bowl and knead that dough until you think you have worked off enough calories to eat a pizza or invest in a stand mixer and a gym membership, 15 minutes of kneading minimum. Put it into a bowl that will allow the dough to double in size and cover with plastic wrap. Place your new dough baby in the fridge and leave it alone for 24 to 36 hours, yeah pizza day is at least 3 days from now and no you can't speed this up. Time makes ok pizza into great pizza.

Pull your dough from the fridge after the first day and break back out that scale. For a 10" pizza 200g of dough will be great, if you're the kind of person who thinks lasagna on bread is pizza, \*cough\* Milanos \*cough\*, reconsider your wrong opinion and keep following this recipe.

Portion out your dough, roll and form them into smooth dough balls. Place on a floured baking sheet tray with approximately 4" of space around each ball, cover with plastic wrap, and put back into the fridge for at least 2 days or up to 4, the longer the better it will taste.

2 to 4 days later remove your dough from the fridge 4 hours before your plan on cooking the pizza to allow it to warm up and become easy to work with. If you're cooking in a wood oven now is a great time to get it fired up, start with a small fire and slowly build it up into a nice base of coals and a steady rate of flames caressing the roof of the oven. For a standard oven, start the process of, I take zero legal liability for this instruction, deactivating your house smoke detectors as you are about to find out how hot your home oven can go. 1 hour before pizza time, preheat the oven (and pizza stone if you have one) to its max temp 5500 f if you got it.

So now you have a 5-day aged dough and a controlled inferno ready to go, you need sauce and toppings. Sauce is easy, if you're a broke student buy some whole canned tomatoes. If the Co-op cheques are pouring in get yourself some D.O.P San Marzano tomatoes from Italy, they sell them in your grocery store I guarantee it, they will be expensive so start your bottle drive now but they are the best/traditional option. Crush them slightly and you're good to go. Yes the sauce is just tomatoes.

Cheese is also easy, fresh mozzarella. It should be soft and creamy. Do not use that block of Black Diamond mild cheddar you bought on sale, there are like 5-6 ingredients in this pizza, use the good stuff. Parmesan cheese; use the best you can afford. Basil, fresh and torn slightly. This is all you need for a truly great pizza, but a couple slices of prosciutto or salami is nice.

It's time to make your pizza, grab a dough ball and work it out on a floured surface, no rolling pin required. You want to be gentle and maintain as much air in the dough as possible, but keep it a thin layer. Next add your tomatoes, just a couple tablespoons as too much will make the pizza watery. Top with a couple slices of your fresh mozzarella or (grated mozzarella if that's all you got). Tear up 4-6 basil


leaves and scatter on top of the pizza and dust the top with freshly grated parmesan and a drizzle of olive oil. If you are using your oven put your pizza directly onto the preheated pizza stone in your oven or onto a greased baking pan and bake for 8-12 minutes or until the crust is crisp and the cheese is bubbly. If you have access to a wood oven, you're putting your pizza directly on the stone and it will need frequent turning and less than 3 minutes to cook.

Is this easier than ordering pizza? No. But it is a hell of a lot tastier and the total time and money investment is far cheaper than any takeout pizza.



#### National Day of Remembrance and Action on Violence Against Women

#### [Content Warning: Gender-based violence]

Here's a bit of history they don't teach you in school: On December 6, 1989, an armed man walked into an engineering building at École Polytechnique de Montréal and murdered 14 young women. His stated motive: "fighting feminism." These women weren't activists or public feminist figures; the mere fact that they were women studying engineering was enough to make them targets of this misogynist act of violence.

While I and many of my female peers have progressed through our engineering education without facing outright gender-based discrimination, we are well aware of the profession's history as a male-dominated space. We are aware that decades' worth of women blazed this trail for us. We have heard remarks that, however benign in their intentions, betrayed a belief that we do not belong here. We've been told that we must be particularly bright or bold or brave to have chosen this path, as if women as engineers are an exception to the rule.

To commemorate the tragedy, the Government of Canada officially recognizes December 6th as the

National Day of Remembrance and Action on Vi-relevance of these discussions. The "meme-ifolence Against Women. This day falls within the internationally-recognized 16 Days of Activism Against Gender-Based Violence, from November 25th to December 10th. These serve as a call to remember the victims of gender-based violence, to take action to prevent this harmful behaviour, and to reflect on how we can do better for people of all marginalized genders.

This year, I encourage you all to take a deliberate moment to:

-Learn more about the history of gender-based oppression from diverse perspectives.

-Seek to amplify the voices of those whose identity makes them less likely to be heard.

-Confront your own biases, be critical about your cultural conditioning, and question the judgements you make based on people's identities.

-Consider how you can call out harmful attitudes in your everyday life.

To speak very broadly, intolerance of any kind is oppressive to everyone. The refusal to acknowledge or accept the wide spectra of sexual orientations, gender identities, neurodivergencies, disabilities, races, ethnicities, or religions is harmful to everyone. And even for those privileged enough to fit society's most rigid mould, intolerance restricts their self-expression with core beliefs that cause harm to themselves and others. Intolerance is a fundamental denial of what it means to be human.

Our C-Eng community is diverse and welcoming, but I know that some of its members don't see the

ication" of social justice has driven many people to roll their eyes at any mention of "privilege" or "oppression." To those people, I implore you to consider how your life and the lives of others have suffered at the hands of the current culture. How might you live your life differently if you lived in a world that didn't consider "able-bodied, white, cis, hetero man" as the default? Who would you be if you didn't have to feel shame or discomfort or fear or hatred toward the parts of yourself that don't fit that ideal? What passions might you pursue? How might society uplift you?
