- Nomination Period: Monday, February 3rd, 2020 @ 8:30 to Friday, February 7th at 17:30.
- All-Candidates Meeting: Friday, February 7th @ 18:00 (location TBA).
- Town Hall: Wednesday, February 26th @ 18:00 (location TBA).
- Campaigning Period: Monday, February 16th @ 8:30 to Tuesday, March 3rd @ 23:59.
- Voting Period: Wednesday, March 4th @ 0:00 to Sunday, March 8th @ 23:59.

LOCATIONS

- All election materials, including nomination forms and regulations, will be available in the CSES Office (ME 3390).
- Completed nomination forms must also be submitted to the CSES Office (ME 3390) before 17:30 on Friday, February 7th, 2020.
- All voting will place online via a link provided to all students through the CU email system.

RESTRICTIONS

- Students wishing to run for a Program Representative position may only run for a seat that represents their own stream of engineering. Similarly, students may not nominate nor vote for Program Representative candidates that will not represent them;
- The number of seats for a particular position represents the maximum number of candidates a student may nominate and/or vote for, for that position;
- Students may not nominate themselves for any position:
- In order to be on CSES Council (i.e. to run as a candidate in the 2020 General Elections), all persons must be 18 years of age or older by May 1, 2020.
- In order to run for CSES Council you must still be opting in to CSES membership fees.

CHIEF ELECTORAL OFFICER AND ELECTORAL COMMITTEE

CHANGE CLAUSE

The CSES Council recognizes that the dates of the Election Period may have to be moved back by 7 days based on OIRP's ability to create the elections lists. The CSES Council allows the Elections Committee to change this date if they deem it necessary. The Elections Committee will give notice of any change that needs to happen as soon as the need becomes known.
